<u>Plagiarism Reference Triffand Enchmark Plagiarism Triff</u>. The purpose is to create a consistent and eqitable application of penalties for <u>provenases</u> of academic misconduct in accordance with the <u>RVC</u> Student Academic Misconduct Procedures.

The AM Penalty System should be used by staff alongside the AM Procedures to help aid the decision-making process. The appointed staff should give additional judgment around mitigating and aggravating factors which cannot be reasonably accounted for in the AM Penalty System.

Assign points based on the following criteria

2nd Time	150 points
3rd/+ Time	200 points

AMOUNT / EXTENT

Below 5% AND less than two sentences	80 points
As above but with critical aspects* plagiarised	105 points
Between 5% and 20% OR more than two sentences but not more than two paragraphs	105 points
As above but with critical aspects* plagiarised	130 points
Between 20% and 50% OR more than two paragraphs but not more than five paragraphs	130 points
As above but with critical aspects* plagiarised	160 points
Above 50% OR more than five paragraphs	160 points

ADDITIONAL CHARACTERISTICS

Evidence of deliberate attempt to disguise plagiarism by changing words, sentences, or references to avoid detection **40 points.**

380+	A formal warning, with a record made contributing to the student's previous history

PENALTIES (Summative Work)

In all cases a formal warning is given, and a record made contributing to the student's previous history
